

Develop a list of 5 ways to check your powers, privileges and biases.

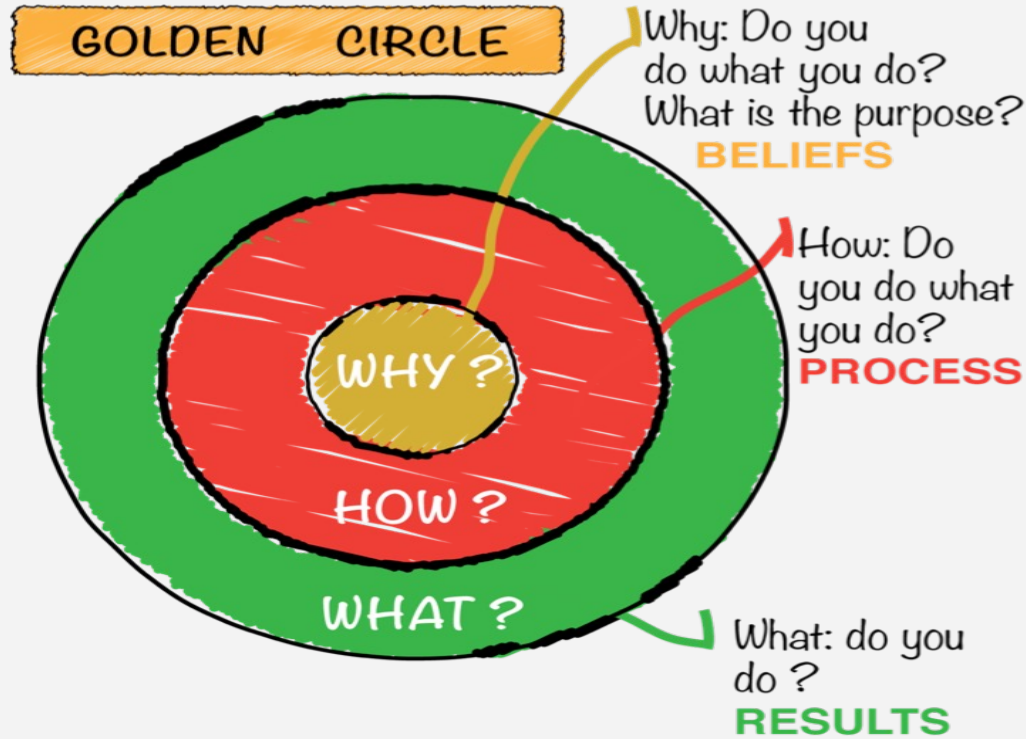




Discuss how you have been able to successfully empower students to self-advocate.
